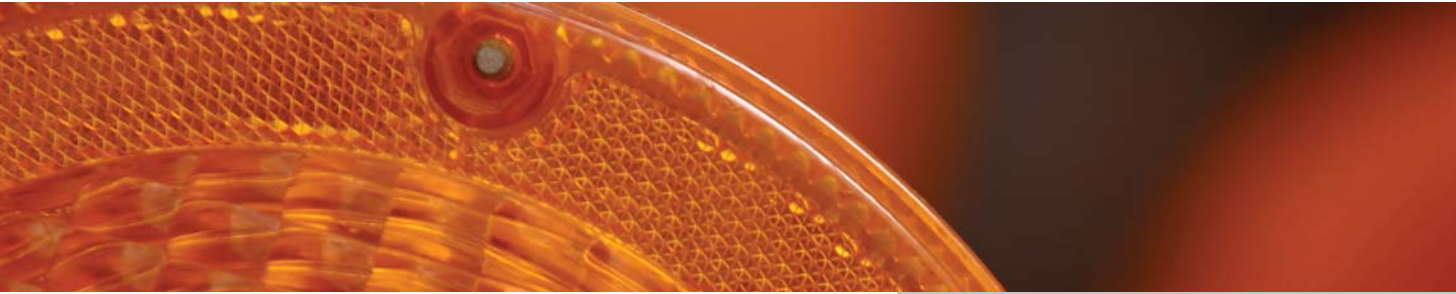


1. Chrisman Road Recycling Plant, Houston, TX
